Grant applications are restricted to tax-exempt public charities, educational or governmental agencies, and must qualify under the Code Section 590(a) of Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

**In order to make the best use of available support, Greene Giving looks to one or more of the following when reviewing proposal requests:**

- The project is a well-planned approach to solving a problem and delivering services
- The use of grants will be innovative and efficient and will not create a duplication of services
- The support is vital or catalytic to the success of the project
- The proposed project is a capital improvement and is expected to continue and expand after grants end
- Expenses will be reduced by sharing resources with other agencies, groups or organizations
