Applications will be considered at the next appropriate meeting of the Philanthropy Committee. Representatives of agencies, charitable organizations and other groups in Greene County are strongly encouraged to discuss their proposal with the Grant Coordinator of Greene Giving at 937-458- 2065 or by emailing Friend@greenegiving.org or with members of the Philanthropy Committee.

Only projects which are of:

- (1) a capital expenditure, defined as such “A capital expenditure is a long-term investment to be acquired, purchased or upgraded asset with a useful life of one year or more. Types of capital expenditure can include computers, equipment, or improvement to a building by a charitable organization. An additional example of capital expenditure can include fixtures, furniture, or a vehicle”, and
- (2) are in direct relevance to the people of the Greene County geographic area will be considered for these grants, and
- (3) restricted to tax-exempt public charities, educational or governmental agencies, and must qualify under the Code Section 590(a) of Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

To make the best use of available support, Greene Giving looks to one or more of the following when reviewing proposal requests:

- The project is a well-planned approach to solving a problem and delivering services
- The use of grants will be innovative and efficient and will not create a duplication of services
- The support is vital or catalytic to the success of the project
- Expenses will be reduced by sharing resources with other agencies, groups, or organizations
- The proposed Grant has a max limit of \$1,000 dollars
- The proposed project is a capital expenditure and is expected to continue and expand after grants end.

The Greene County Community Foundation does not approve grants to support general operating expenses, deficit financing, grants to individuals, endowments, or membership contributions.
