Applications will be considered at the next appropriate meeting of the Philanthropy Committee. Representatives of agencies, charitable organizations and other groups in Greene County are strongly encouraged to discuss their proposal with the Grant Coordinator of Greene Giving at 937-458- 2065 or by emailing [Friend@greenegiving.org](mailto:Friend@greenegiving.org) or with members of the Philanthropy Committee.

Only projects which are of:

- (1) are in direct relevance to the animal welfare as related to senior pet owners of the Greater Dayton geographic area will be considered for these grants ,and
- (2) used for services provided by Veterinarians affiliated with organizations such as the Humane Society of Greene County or SISCA (Society for the Improvement of Conditions for Stray Animals), with preference given to “no-kill” facilities ,and
- (3) restricted to tax-exempt public charities, educational or governmental agencies, and must qualify under the Code Section 590(a) of Internal Revenue Service (IRS), or grants may be allowed to non 501(C)(3) organizations if there is documented charitable activity benefiting or serving senior citizens in need of assistance caring for their pets.

To make the best use of available support, Greene Giving looks to one or more of the following when reviewing proposal requests:

- The project is a well-planned approach to solving a problem and delivering services
- The use of grants will be innovative and efficient and will not create a duplication of services
- The support is vital or catalytic to the success of the project
- Expenses will be reduced by sharing resources with other agencies, groups, or organizations
- Grants may be used for services and medications including follow-up care resulting from complications of surgery.
- may only be used to euthanize a pet as a last resort
- Grants should not be used for routine veterinary care, routine spay and neuter services except by special consideration resulting from extenuating circumstances.
